

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE COURT

- ___ Take and complete the Domestic Violence Intervention Program or any other program deemed appropriate by your Probation Officer;
- ___ To attend Court for monitoring of Probation / Conditional Sentence order on _____, 20__ at 9:30 a.m. or at the date indicated by your Probation Officer upon your release from incarceration;
- ___ Not to have any contact, directly or indirectly, with _____ except through legal counsel. Indirect contact will be allowed solely for the purpose of access to the children through _____ or pursuant to the terms of a Court Order granted by the Court of Queen's Bench – Family Division.

CONDITIONS

- ___ Keep the peace and be of good behaviour (especially towards _____);
- ___ Appear before the Court when required to do so by the Court;
- ___ Report to the Conditional Sentence Supervisor / Probation Officer immediately, and afterwards as required by the Supervisor / Officer;
- ___ To have no (not to initiate) contact, directly or indirectly, with _____;
- ___ Not to associate with or be in the company of _____;
- ___ Not to attend at the premises of _____; and not to attend his / her place of employment, school, or any other place he / she is known to be;
- ___ Not to attend any _____ store in Moncton, Westmorland County, or New Brunswick;
- ___ Abstain completely from the consumption and/or possession of alcohol and/or illegal or non-prescribed drugs;
- ___ Report to the _____, _____ times per week, (in person / by telephone), on _____ between the hours of _____ and _____;
- ___ Promptly notify within 24 hours – Court / Probation Officer / Supervisor – of any change in your name, address, employment or occupation, education status, and phone number;
- ___ Abstain from owning, possessing, or carrying a weapon;
- ___ Attend at Addiction Services to undergo assessment and follow prescribed treatment, if deemed necessary, for substance abuse (alcohol and/or drug dependency);
- ___ To attend at Mental Health to undergo assessment and treatment, if deemed necessary, and follow through to completion;
- ___ Perform _____ hours of community service work as directed by your Probation Officer or Supervisor over the period of _____;
- ___ Remain within the jurisdiction of the Court unless written permission to go outside that jurisdiction is obtained from the Court or the Supervisor;
- ___ To reside at _____ and remain at your place of residence at all times, 24 hours a day, for the first _____ months, and for the remaining _____ months you shall obey a curfew and you shall remain in your place of residence between the hours of _____ and _____, except for the purpose of:
 - (i) Travelling to a place of employment by the shortest available route, to remain there during usual working hours, and to return to your place of residence by the shortest available route;
 - (ii) Attending a counselling appointment, a treatment program, a meeting of Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, or Gamblers Anonymous at the direction of your Supervisor or Probation Officer, travel to and from by the most direct route;
 - (iii) Attending a scheduled appointment with your Legal Counsel, Sentence Supervisor or Probation Officer;
 - (iv) Attending for medical or dental services;
 - (v) Attending to other personal matters between the hours of _____ and _____ each _____ or such other weekly three-hour period as may be allowed by your Supervisor;
- ___ Obey a curfew whereby you shall remain in your place of residence each and every day between the hours of _____ and _____;
- ___ Prove compliance with the house arrest and curfew conditions by answering the telephone or presenting yourself at the entrance of your residence should a Peace Officer, your Sentence Supervisor, or any other authorized personnel call you or attend your residence to check on your compliance;
- ___ To maintain a workable landline telephone at all times. Number: _____
- ___ Follow counselling at the direction of your Probation Officer / Conditional Sentence Supervisor;
- ___ Attend Anger Management Program at the direction of your Probation Officer and follow through to completion;
- ___ Attend at a treatment program _____ approved by the Province of New Brunswick;
- ___ Make all reasonable efforts to locate and maintain employment and report those efforts to your Supervisor as required;
- ___ Donate \$ _____ to a charity of your choice or to _____ and provide receipt to your Probation Officer / Conditional Sentence Supervisor on or before _____;
- ___ Make restitution in the amount of \$ _____ payable to the Minister of Finance at any Provincial Court office within the province of New Brunswick by cash, certified cheque or money order, for the benefit of _____ to be paid on or before _____;
