

CONDITIONAL SENTENCE ORDER

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The Court sentences you to imprisonment of _____ (less than two years) and is satisfied that your serving the sentence in the community will not endanger its safety. You shall serve this sentence in the community under the following conditions:

- Keep the peace and be of good behaviour.
- Appear before the Court when required to do so by the Court.
- Report to a supervisor at 26-28 Prince Arthur Street, Amherst, on or before _____ and *thereafter* as required and in the manner directed by the supervisor or someone acting in his/her stead.
- **Reside** within the Province of Nova Scotia unless written permission to **reside** outside the Province is obtained from the Court or the supervisor; and
- Notify promptly the supervisor in advance of any change of name or address *or telephone number*, and promptly notify the supervisor of any changes of employment or occupation.

AND IN ADDITION, YOU SHALL:

- Not possess or consume alcohol or any other intoxicating substances.
- Not possess or consume a controlled substance as defined in the **Controlled Drugs and Substances Act** except in accordance with a physician's prescription for you or a legal authorization.
- Not enter or be in any premises where alcohol is the primary product of sale including liquor stores, taverns, pubs, beverage rooms, night clubs and licenced pool halls.
- Not own, possess or carry any weapon, firearm, cross-bow, prohibited weapon, restricted weapon, prohibited device, ammunition or explosive substance as those items are defined in the **Criminal Code**.
- Attend for, participate in and successfully complete any and all counselling, assessment, treatment or program as directed by your supervisor, including but not limited to:
 - mental health
 - substance abuse
 - urinalysis or other alcohol or controlled substance screening
 - anger management
 - violence intervention and prevention program (*spousal/partner related*)
 - gambling addiction
 - and pay the cost or a portion of the cost as directed by your supervisor.
- Have no direct or indirect contact or communication with _____ except:
 - through legal counsel
 - with _____ expressed consent received in advance in writing
 - incidental contact in an education or treatment program or while at work
 - in accordance with a written separation agreement or court order for access to a child or children
- Not be on or within _____ metres of the premises known as: _____ except: _____
- Not associate with or be in the company of any person known to you to have a **Criminal Code** record, **Controlled Drugs and Substances Act** record, or Youth Justice Court record, unless you have the written permission of your supervisor to associate with such an individual, or unless your association with any such individual is incidental to your attendance at employment or at a program of counselling in which you are participating, or unless that person is a member of your immediate family.
- Take all medications as prescribed for you by a licensed physician in the manner so prescribed.
- Make reasonable efforts to locate and maintain employment or an educational program as directed by your supervisor.
- Complete _____ hours of community service work under the direction and supervision of your supervisor by _____ (or within _____ months).

- CURFEW:** Abide by a curfew daily in your residence from _____ p.m. until _____ a.m. the following day, seven days a week commencing _____.
- HOUSE ARREST:** Remain in your residence at all times beginning at _____ p.m. on _____.

For the purposes of this order, "residence" is defined as the dwelling house located at _____ and surrounding lands within _____ metres of the dwelling.

THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS TO THE CURFEW/HOUSE ARREST ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- when at regularly scheduled employment, which your supervisor knows about, and travelling to and from that employment by the most direct route.
- when attending at a regularly scheduled education program, which your supervisor knows about, or at a school or educational activity supervised by a principal or teacher, and travelling to and from the education program or activity by the most direct route.
- when dealing with a medical emergency or medical appointment involving you or a member of your household, and travelling to and from by the most direct route.
- when attending a scheduled appointment with your lawyer or a supervisor, and travelling to and from the appointment by the most direct route.
- when attending court at a scheduled appearance or under subpoena, and travelling to and from court by the most direct route.
- when attending a counselling appointment, a treatment program or a meeting of Alcoholics Anonymous or Narcotics Anonymous, at the direction of or with the permission of your supervisor, and travelling to and from that appointment, program or meeting, by the most direct route.
- when attending a regularly scheduled religious service with the permission of your supervisor, and travelling to and from that service by the most direct route.
- when making application for employment or attending job interviews, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and travelling to and from by the most direct route.
- when in a residential treatment program if your supervisor is told, in advance, where you will be and you agree that the facility can tell your supervisor if you are there, should your supervisor inquire.
- with written approval of your supervisor given beforehand.
- when performing community service work arranged with your supervisor, and travelling to and from the location by the most direct route.
- for a period of _____ consecutive hours each week, approved in advance by your supervisor, for the purpose of running errands and attending to your personal needs.
